What have we done

- Speeding checks between 01/08/2024 and 31/08/2024.
 - Five visits to A47, one visit to the A6003 Great Easton and eight visits to B6047 at along the bike route.
- Identifying and targeting the individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach.
- Increasing patrols in areas where anti social behaviour is being reported to us.

The #PCC's Community day continues with a visit to Wellington Place out on patrol with the local beat officer to be shown the local hotspots for ASB & to understand what is being done to reduce the problems. Overall crime levels across #MarketHarborough are down, with significant reductions in Violence against the person, Theft and Public disorder Offences.
